- We recommend that all folders and notebooks be labeled with the subject and child's name.
 - As you shop for school clothes, please refer to the Dress Code Guidelines in the Parent Handbook. **Strict adherence is required.**
 - Gym: **Only gym shoes with laces and/or Velcro are allowed.** No hiking boots, zip-ons, slip-ons, Crocs, or casual shoes permitted. Grades 5-8 are required to have a change of clothes for Gym- a separate t-shirt and pants or shorts to the knee, socks, gym shoes, and deodorant.
 - Correction fluid (white-out) is **not** allowed in school.
